

# Utility Improvement Project Public Announcement: Construction to Resume

The City of Flandreau would like to inform residents and businesses that construction activities for the Utility Improvement Project will resume soon, depending on weather and site conditions.

Utility crews are expected to return the week of March 23rd for roadway preparation and site management. Temporary water line installation is planned to begin the week of March 30th, starting near the intersection of Wind Street and Elm Avenue. Sidewalk work will resume in areas that remain exposed.

In May, asphalt paving is anticipated along Park Avenue (from Wind Street to Prairie Street) and Wind Street (from Park Avenue to Broad Avenue), once asphalt plants reopen.

Beginning in May, roadway utility installation will continue east from Prairie Street toward Summit Street.

Public meetings may tentatively resume in mid-April, with details to be shared as they are confirmed. Residents are reminded to watch for posted signs, exercise caution around construction zones, and be aware of construction equipment.
